



## Application for HSBC Bank of Canada Prize

**Application Deadline: 4 p.m., Thursday, May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2023**

A \$1,200 prize is offered by HSBC Bank Canada in memory of the Okanagan Mountain Park Fire. The prizes are awarded to a student in the Irving K. Barber Faculty of Science, or the Irving K. Barber Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences, or the Faculty of Health and Social Development, or the Faculty of Creative and Critical Studies at the University of British Columbia, Okanagan campus who has conducted a research project or special initiative that examines the sociological, economical, ecological, environmental, psychological, or health impacts of environmental disturbances (terrestrial, aquatic, marine; natural or human-caused). The prize will be conferred upon a student from each of the following Schools and Faculties, in successive years, and in this order: the Irving K. Barber Faculty of Science, Irving K. Barber Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences, Faculty of Health and Social Development, and then the Faculty of Creative and Critical Studies.

### Application Process:

#### Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria:

- You meet the minimum [Senate Regulations Governing University Awards](#).
- You are a BSc student in the Irving K. Barber Faculty of Science.
- You are an outstanding academic student with a **minimum 80% GPA**.
- You are conducting a research project or special initiative relevant to the award description.
- You have one reference who can attest to your involvement in the project.

**Step 2:** Save the PDF form and complete it using Adobe Acrobat Reader.

**Step 3:** Ensure that your form is signed by yourself and your reference.
